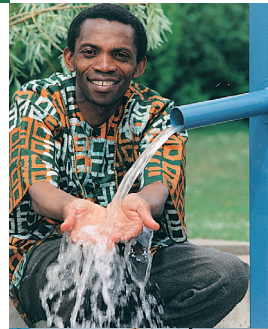
Working with you
